

# GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

## 1. Entry to the Festival

Entry to the festival is allowed only with a valid ticket.

Each visitor will receive, upon entry, an identification wristband, which replaces the ticket and grants access to the festival grounds. The wristband is non-transferable.

Damage, loss, or removal of the wristband results in the loss of the right to enter without refund.

Visitors are required to wear the wristband for the entire duration of their stay in the festival grounds and present it upon request.

## 2. Visitor Obligations

Visitors undertake to:

- comply with these terms and conditions and with instructions given by the organizer and security personnel
- behave in a manner that does not endanger the health, safety of persons, or property
- maintain order within the festival grounds
- respect other visitors

Participation in the festival is voluntary, and each visitor participates at their own risk.

---

## 3. Prohibited Conduct

The following items are prohibited within the festival grounds:

- glass containers, cans, and other hazardous items
- weapons of any kind
- pyrotechnics, flammable substances, and open flames
- narcotics and psychotropic substances
- laser pointers
- professional recording or filming equipment without the organizer's consent
- personal alcohol

Furthermore, it is prohibited to:

- enter inaccessible or restricted areas
  - enter the stage or backstage areas
  - damage the grounds or its equipment, including greenery
  - throw objects among visitors
  - use the restroom outside designated areas
  - bring animals (except assistance dogs)
  - distribute or display advertising or promotional materials without prior consent from the organizer

## **4. Organizer's Rights**

The organizer is entitled to:

- refuse entry or remove from the premises any person who violates these terms and conditions, without any right to a refund
  - conduct security checks at the entrance in a reasonable manner, including the inspection of personal belongings
  - issue binding instructions to ensure the safety and proper conduct of the event
  - change the program (line-up), schedule, location, or date of the event for organizational, safety, or unforeseen reasons
  - amend these terms and conditions in a reasonable manner if necessary for safety or organizational purposes

## **5. Liability**

Visitors are liable for any damage they cause.

The organizer is liable for damage only to the extent provided by law, particularly if caused by a breach of their obligations.

The organizer is not liable for:

- loss, theft, or damage to visitors' personal property
  - damages resulting from the visitor's negligence or violation of these terms and conditions
  - damages caused by third parties if such damages could not have been prevented despite reasonable effort

## **6. Changes to Program, Location, and Date**

The organizer reserves the right to change the festival program, schedule, location, or date, particularly due to adverse weather, safety measures, decisions of public authorities, or other unforeseen circumstances.

In the event of a change of location, date, or program, the visitor is not entitled to a refund, provided that the festival takes place at an alternative location or date in a comparable scope.

If it is not possible to hold the festival on the planned date, the organizer may decide to reschedule it to an alternative date. In such a case, tickets remain valid.

## **7. Cancellation of the Event**

If the festival cannot take place at all and no alternative is provided, the visitor is entitled to a refund of the ticket price.

---

## **8. Personal Data and Audiovisual Recordings**

By entering the festival, visitors acknowledge that photographs, videos, or other audiovisual recordings may be taken on the premises.

These recordings may be used by the organizer for documentation, reporting, and promotional purposes, without any claim for compensation by the visitor.

## **9. Final Provisions**

Visitors are required to leave the festival grounds after the event ends.

By entering the festival, visitors confirm that they have read, understood, and agreed to these terms and conditions.
